Chief complaint: bilateral lower lid entropion and heartworm treatment

History was treated for heartworm preventative 1 month ago and castrated.

Physical exam bar hydrated pink mm entropion O.D worse than O.S. of lower lid.

Problem Plan

1. entropion surgery. A sharp incision with a number 15 scapel blade was made at the junction of the haired and non haired region of the lower lid to the extent of the entropion. A second incision at the estimated distance to remove a wedge of skin to correct the entropion. The wedge was removed with straight and curved metzenbaum scissors. 00000 polysorb was placed simple intradermal and continous intradermal patterns to oppose the edges of the wound and correct the entropion

2. BNP wit dexamethasone was administered and dispensed to decrease swelling

3. 2.3 cc immiticide was injected into the left paralumbar musculature.

Problem Plan

1. 24 g left cephalic catheter 50 cc

2. 3 cc pen g sub q

3. 2.5 cc immiticide right lumbar next treatment around 7/4/2009

4. ears flushed with malacetic acid

5. Orchidectomy: A sharp incision was made over entrapped right testicle cranial to the scrotum. The testicle was exteriorized. The ligament of the epididymis was clamped and manually broken. The spermatic cord was clamped and ligated with 000 polysorb. The left side was handled similarly. The skin was closed with 000 polysorb intradermally. Tissue adhesive was placed over the wound
