A second incision at the estimated distance to remove a wedge of skin to correct the entropion. The wedge was removed with straight and curved metzenbaum scissors. 00000 polysorb was placed simple intradermal and continous intradermal patterns to oppose the edges of the wound and correct the entropion

2 BNP wit dexamethasone was administered and dispensed to decrease swelling

3 2.3 cc immiticide was injected into the left paralumbar musculature
