Doctor's Instructions

Heartworm Rapid Test x 1

Question*

Why did my veterinarian recommend a heartworm test today?

Answer

Annual testing is recommended for several important reasons. First, many of us do not take our own medications as directed let alone medicate our pets. We're busy; we forget; we miss a dose here and there. Second, even if you never miss a dose there is nothing to prevent your dog from eating some grass and vomiting up the medication you just

gave. Your pet would be without protection for an entire month. Third, if your pet accidentally became infected with heartworms, your veterinarian needs to detect it as soon as possible before irreversible heart and lung damage occur. Early detection and treatment are always best. Finally, some heartworm tests now come combined with tests that monitor other significant diseases (Lyme disease, Ehrlichiosis and Anaplasmosis). With annual testing, you know your pet is heartworm free and not infected with these serious tick-borne diseases, some of which could affect family members. The tests are quick and accurate and make sure your pet is free from infection. Annual testing provides peace of mind in knowing that your pet is free of heartworms, and should your pet be infected, it assures you of early diagnosis.

Canine Spay (30- 50lbs)

Your pet has had a spay surgery under general anesthetic yesterday. The effects of the anesthetic can last up to 24 hours so your pet should be monitored carefully to avoid injury. Our goal now is a quick and comfortable recovery at home. Your pet can be fed normally today.

Sutures will need to be removed in 10-14 days. This service is included in the price of the procedure, but an appointment should be scheduled. Please do not bathe your pet until sutures are removed.

Please monitor your pet's incision daily and notify the clinic if any swelling, redness, or discharge occurs. Discourage your pet from licking and chewing the incision. We recommend an e-collar for your pet during the healing process.

Your pet's incision is healing so exercise should be restricted for the next 5-7 days. Short leash walks only for dogs and try to limit jumping.

If your pet is sent home with medication, please follow the instructions on the label carefully.

We make every effort to ensure the comfort and well being of your pet. But complications post surgical can occur.
