

#### CANINE HEARTWORM DISEASE

Heartworm Life Cycle

- The mosquito bites a dog releasing heartworm larvae into the animal
- The larvae grow as they travel through the tissues heading to the heart and lungs.
- They finally reach the heart where they inflict damage to the heart and lung vessels.
- Adult heartworms (about the size of spaghetti strands) give birth to live offspring called microfilaria
- · Microfilaria are tiny. They circulate in the infected animals blood stream where a mosquito picks them up
- The mosquito then travels to another dog where the life cycle begins again.

Once a dog is diagnosed with heartworms he/she needs to go to a veterinarian of your choice. The veterinarian will discuss the treatment that will be best for your dog. HEARTTEST
